- b) Should have 50% marks in Physics, Chemistry, Biology and English put together

3. ACADEMIC:

- a) Candidate should have passed Higher Secondary examination conducted by Board of Higher Secondary Education, Kerala, or examination equivalent there to as approved by Directorate of Medical Education, Thiruvananthapuram
- b) Rounding off of the percentage of marks to the nearest whole number is not permitted
- c) Candidates who have passed their qualifying examinations from the states other than Kerala shall produce the certificate of recognition and equivalence of qualifying examination

4. NATIONALITY

Only Indian citizens are eligible for admission to professional courses unless otherwise notified

5. AGE:

The applicant should have completed 17 years of age as on 31-03-2023

Original and 2 copies of the following certificates should be submitted along with the application form, failing the same lead to the rejection of application.

- a) SSLC or equivalent Certificate to prove date of birth
- b) Plus Two Mark list(s) of qualifying Examination (HSC/equivalent)
- c) Conduct certificate
- d) Transfer certificate
- e) Migration certificate (If necessary)
- f) Aadhar card
- g) Physical fitness (*A medical fitness certificate showing suitability to undergo the course

* - A prescribed format should be collected from the office at the time of admission)

7. PROCEDURE FOR SELECTION

7.1 Selection will be based on the rank list prepared on the basis of marks obtained in **Physics, Chemistry and Biology and English put together** in the qualifying examination.

In case of a tie in the total marks computed for ranking, candidates with higher marks obtained in Biology will be placed higher in the ranking. If the tie still exists, the candidate with higher marks obtained in Chemistry will be placed higher in the ranking. If the tie still exists, the candidate with higher marks obtained in Physics will be placed higher in the ranking. If the tie still exists, the percentage of total marks for the qualifying examination and then the percentage of marks in English in the qualifying examination will be considered for breaking the tie. Even after this, if tie remains, the age of the candidate will be taken into account and the older will be placed higher in ranking than the younger. If the tie still persists, the alphabetical order of the names of the candidates in English will be taken into account (eg. 'A' has a higher priority than 'B' and so on)

- **7.2** Furnishing false information or particulars would result in the forfeiture of the candidature as well as cancellation of admission to the course. In addition, it will invite the relevant provisions of the criminal law of the land.
- **7.3** After scrutiny of applications, selected candidates will be informed through phone and the list will be published in the notice boards of the college. Selection will be strictly in the order of merit.
- 7.4 The selected candidate will appear for the interview and final selection without fail.

8. ADMISSION

- **8.1** For genuine reasons, principal will have the right to deny admission to any candidate even if otherwise eligible.
- **8.2** No marks will be allotted for interview.
- **8.3** Selected candidates shall take admission at the appointed time and date in the college after paying the admission fee, tuition fee, caution deposit etc, failing which the offer of admission will be cancelled. Tuition & special fee should be paid at the time of admission.

9.1 Refund of fees

After closure of admissions, the seat if vacated cannot be filled up. Such seats will go vacant for the entire duration of the course. Therefore, those who leave the course after the closure of admissions will have to pay liquidated damages equivalent to the tuitions fees for the remaining period of the course. Any complaints in this regard shall be subject to the legal and factual scrutiny and the decisions of the ASC/FRC. The college shall return the Certificate and TC of these students, on execution of a bond by the student along with any of his/her Parents, undertaking to pay the amount that maybe ordered by the ASC/FRC of the Court of Law.

Those who leave the course after commencement of classes, but before closure of admissions, tuition fees will be refunded provided the institution could fill up the vacancy

<u>10. CODE OF CONDUCT</u>

11. CAUTION

11.1 Prohibition of Ragging:-
